### **Color Blind**


The Forgotten Team that Broke Baseball's Color Line by Tom Dunkel

As you look forward to summer, it is not too early to plan your summer reading choices. Let me recommend Color Blind by Tom Dunkel. This book, a Booklist Top Ten Sports Book of the Year and set in Bismarck, North Dakota, tells the story of a depression-era baseball team composed of players who couldn't make the pros because of age and race. Led by legendary Satchel Paige, the team makes it to the 1935 National Semipro Tournament. Kirkus

Reviews describes the book as a well-told account of a fascinating, and forgotten, chapter in the history of America's national pastime.
